

Autism Support Network - TikTok Live Stream Rules

- 18+ to join the panel
- No harmful language, personal insults or any type of prejudice
- Conversations off topic will time limited or moved to the chat
- No misinformation or selling

Opening - Start of Live/ Middle of Live

“We are a **not-for-profit organisation, providing education, support and fundraising for vulnerable people in our community.** The trust and safety of our community is our priority. **We do not allow selling, misinformation, ableism or any kind of prejudice or harmful language on the panel OR in the chat.** Please try not to swear as we may have young listeners and keep conversations respectful, inclusive and neuro-affirming. **If you break the rules you will be dropped to the chat to listen or blocked. You must be 18+ to join the panel per TikTok Terms of Service,** but everyone that can respect our standards is welcome in our space. We are family.

Please respect our rules. Protect the live. and help us keep our community safe.”

Followed by the usual engagement blurb (taps, likes, shares and Heart Me, gift goals, membership to our charitable organisation, donations (links in bio).

Each Guest That Joins the Panel

“Thank you for joining us. Please could you confirm your age for TikTok and pronouns if you wish?”

- If they are under 18 - “18+ to join panel but welcome to stay in the chat and listen.”

If guests break the rules - please mute straight away and state the rule that was broken and remind them to stick to the rules of the live. If they don't respect the boundary, drop to the chat and announce why.

e.g. “we had to drop/ block xxxx as they were not adhering to our community rules which protect the live and our community members.”

Mods make the call about the severity of the behaviour and whether to remind, mute, drop or block. Ableism, racism, sexism, xenophobia and all types of prejudice etc should be an immediate block in my opinion - Mods call.
